

The LSU College Readiness Program offers a dual enrollment (DE) opportunity for high school students to earn credit for both an LSU course and a high school course at the same time while remaining on the high school campus. The following LSU math courses are offered for dual credit to qualifying high school students:

- Math 1021 College Algebra paired with the first half of high school Advanced Math
- Math 1022 Trigonometry paired with the second half of high school Advanced Math

Requirements for Advanced Math/LSU Dual Enrollment for College Algebra (Fall Course)-

- Student must have a minimum composite ACT score of 18 (ACT Aspire scores cannot be used)
- Student must have a minimum composite MATH ACT score of 19
- Student must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.0
- Cost for College Algebra Dual Enrollment is \$300

Requirements for Advanced Math/LSU Dual Enrollment for College Trigonometry (Spring Course)-

- Student must have successfully completed College Algebra Dual Enrollment course or have a minimum composite MATH ACT score of 25
- Cost for Trigonometry Dual Enrollment is \$300

***Student will earn 3 hours of college credit per course
