Dear Elementary Parents,

We hope our families have been enjoying a safe and happy summer! It's hard to believe in just a few short weeks we'll be kicking off another successful school year. An orientation has been scheduled for parents of students in grades Pre-K through 4 on Monday, August 7th, 2017 at 4:30pm in the school cafeteria. At this time, general information will be provided regarding the 2017-18 school year. Following the general session, parents will be able to meet with their child(ren)'s teacher(s) in their classrooms. Please be advised this a time reserved for **parents and teachers only**. You may bring your child's school supplies with you at this time. We ask that you please make sure all items are clearly labeled with your child's first and last name. The school supply lists for each grade level are available on the school website at www.falseriveracademy.org.

The first day of school for students will be Thursday, August 10th, 2017. This is a full day of school for all students entering grades 1-12 (breakfast/lunch will be served and buses will be in operation). A very important change for the 2017-18 school year is the operating time for our school day. **The school day will now commence at 7:45am and dismiss at 2:45pm.**

Our school administration is comprised of two divisions, Mrs. Kristen Graffeo with the elementary division grades PreK3-6 and Mrs. Ashley Allen with the junior high and high school grades 7-12. Please take a moment to preview the 2017-18 school calendar posted to our school website. In an effort to provide a safe environment for our students and faculty, please be advised that parents are not allowed in the hallways or classrooms between the hours 7:45 a.m. – 2:45 p.m. without a visitor pass which can be obtained through the offices. If you need a conference with a teacher, please schedule appointments through the elementary office at 225-638-8610. Also, please make every effort to avoid checking out your child for reasons other than emergencies during school hours. If a child is to be checked out early from school, a letter to school the morning of the check-out is required. Check-ins/outs for students in PK-6th grade are transacted in the elementary office. Students in grades 7-12 can be checked-in/out through the high school office. **Transportation arrangements will NOT be taken over the phone unless it is an emergency.**
