- 1 book sack large enough for binder and books to fit in
- 2 single-subject notebooks
- 1 marble composition book – will be homework assignment pad
- 1-inch binder (NO LARGER!) with clear plastic insert on front
- 3 hard plastic (poly) folders with pockets and holes (no prongs!) in the following colors – 1 black, 1 blue (for AM), and 1 any solid color put inside the binder
- 1 pkg. of wide-ruled loose leaf paper – leave unopened!
- 3 mechanical pencils with 9mm lead
- 1 lead refill for the mechanical pencils
- 1 pair scissors
- 1 small bottle of glue
- 1 box of 24 crayons – NO LARGER!
- 2 boxes of classic color markers – 1 thin line and 1 thick line
- 1 zipper bag - large enough to hold scissors, glue, colors, and markers
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 large size disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol)
- 1 roll of paper towels
