2026 – 2027 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Supply List

- 1 booksack labeled with your child's name
  - 3 Mead Five Star PLASTIC folders. Folders must have prongs inside (Open folder and neatly label the left side pocket "Return to School" and label the right side pocket "Keep at Home". Only label 2 of the 3 folders) NO BLACK FOLDERS
  - 1 pack of wide ruled loose leaf paper
  - (BOYS ONLY) 1 pack of white card stock
  - (GIRLS ONLY) 1 pack of colored cardstock
  - 1 watercolor paint set (labeled with your child's name)
  - 1 cloth book cover (large size)
  - 1 large zipper bag (labeled with your child's name)
  - 1 box markers (10) (labeled with your child's name)
  - 1 pack of Expo Dry Erase Markers
  - 2 marble composition notebook (labeled with your child's name)
  - 2 boxes of pencils SHARPENED (If in Ms. Chloe's – Ticonderoga pencils ONLY)
  - 2 boxes of crayons (no more than 24 in a box) (labeled with your child's name)
  - 1 pair of scissors
  - 2 bottle of glue
  - 3 boxes of Kleenex
  - 3 rolls of paper towels
  - 3 packs of baby wipes
  - 1 pack of Clorox wipes
  - 1 box of Ziploc bags (boys – quart size / girls – gallon size)
  - 1 pair of over the ear headphones
  - \$35 party fee for all class/holiday parties during the year. The teacher will purchase all goodies for all parties. This fee will also cover things I purchase for cooking activities that go with lessons throughout the year.

  - Extra supplies will be collected and stores in the classroom and passed out as needed throughout the school year to your child. After Christmas, I will let you know if your child is in of more supplies.
